Everyone in a Trust produces waste and its production can cause ever increasing management challenges ranging from local stream segregation to cost control. Are you compliant to the latest legislation and HTM guidance? The DoH Environment and Sustainability Health Technical Memorandum 07-01 on the Safe Management of Healthcare Waste require evidence based periodic Pre Waste Acceptance Audits and evidential improvements. DGSA assessments also aim to ensure prevention, segregation, handling, transportation, and disposal of waste is properly managed to minimise risks. The Landfill Regulations 2002 (Section 10) calls on waste producers to minimise waste to landfill and increase recycling. Are you compliant to the WEEE Regulations 2013?

Are you committed to the NHS Carbon Reduction Strategy (January 2014) and use Site Waste Management Plans within your construction projects? What legislative drivers apply in delivering a sustainable healthcare estate? How do we use BREEAM Healthcare in projects and minimise our carbon footprint?

Key issues also to be covered on the day include:

- 'Duty of Care' and documentation processes in correctly identifying, describing and packaging waste e.g. cytotoxic and sharps waste, sharps, offensive, anatomical etc.
- Challenges in monitoring the waste hierarchy in a healthcare environment
- Potential benefits in moving towards the use of alternative technology for the disposal of low-level infectious waste
- Health and safety risks posed by introducing more waste streams
- Financial aspects and resource implications of training staff in further waste segregation
- Contingency planning

The conference brings together speakers from a variety of backgrounds to explore the change process in moving from disposal to using waste as a managed/recycled resource within legislative frameworks and the waste industry developments.
